

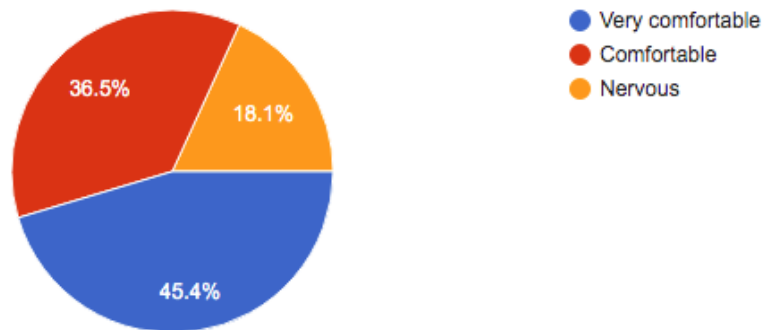
# COVID PARENT SURVEY RESULTS

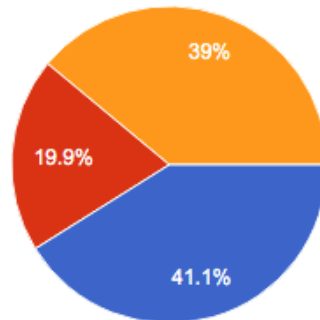

If quarantine numbers continue to rise and the district is faced with two options which would you be inclined to support?

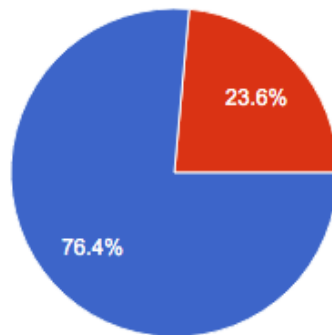

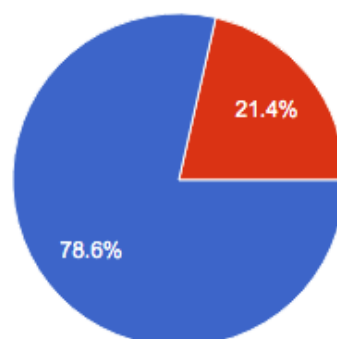
