Dress Code

Ladies Formal Wear

Formal/Evening dresses are required. They may be strapless or off the shoulder if they meet the other criteria listed below:

- Dresses cannot be too revealing in the front/back/sides or slit too high (above fingertips).
- Dresses cannot be inappropriately "see through".
- Dresses cannot be casual skirts or pants.
- Only appropriate jewelry may be worn, excluding spiked, studded jewelry, nose rings, etc.

Gentlemen Formal Wear

- All clothing must be in good repair, clean and pressed. Jeans of any type or color are not allowed.
- Only appropriate jewelry may be worn, excluding spiked, studded jewelry, nose rings, etc.
- Policy on facial hair in Student Handbook applies.

Student Conduct and General Information

- No guests allowed over the age of 20.
- All students and guests must sign in.
- Once you exit the school, you will not be permitted to re-enter.
- There are no refunds on tickets.
- There will be no provocative or lewd dancing:
 - No moshing/slam dancing
 - No dancing that could result in the injury of yourself or others
 - No sexually suggestive dancing
- You will need to provide a copy of your guest's driver's license.
- Chaperones will determine what is appropriate or disrespectful. Students who violate the dance code will be asked to leave the dance and the emergency contact will be called.
- If you have a question about whether a certain style of dress is appropriate, please see the principal.
- Please remember that this is a school function and all rules from the Student Handbook do apply.
- I agree that if I do not follow the above rules I may not be granted admittance to or may be asked to leave the dance and the emergency contact will be called.
- **All students must have signed permission form turned in by the deadline in order to be admitted.**
