

## Middle School Incentive Program

Below are the requirements for attending the incentive reward at the end of each nine weeks. Points are posted each week in a designated classroom so that students can check their status. It is the student's responsibility to speak to a teacher if there is a concern regarding an incentive point. Points are reset to zero at the beginning of each nine weeks.

- Students with 8 or more incentive points in the following areas are eliminated from the reward. (7 points is fine; 8 points is elimination)  
Incentive points may be given for:
  - Homework and classwork in all content areas
  - Disruptive behavior
  - Off task behavior
  - Tardies to class
  - Class supplies
  - Disrespect
  - Chromebook
  - PDA
  - Dress Code
  - Mrs. Godby
- Attendance - A student is eliminated if they have more than 12.56 hours of unexcused absences from school during the nine weeks. 12.56 hours is equivalent to two full days of school. These 12.56 hours include unexcused tardies to school. Every second counts!
  - 12.56 unexcused hours is fine; 12.57 hours is not.
  - Note: An unexcused absence occurs when there is no phone call or note from a parent. Students are allowed 60 hours of excused absences each year with a parent note or call. After that, all absences must be medically excused by a physician.
- Automatic elimination for any of the following:
  - OSS - Out of School Suspension
  - ISS - In School Suspension
  - After School Detention
  - Saturday School
- A student must be enrolled for the entire nine weeks in order to be eligible for the reward at the end of each nine weeks.

Note: Students who earn 14 and 21 incentive points will receive an after school detention. Students who earn 28, 35, and 42 points will receive a Saturday School.

Note: Possible quarterly rewards may include: a school dance, bowling trip, roller skating trip, trip to the movie theater, additional free time outside or in the gym
