## ATTENDANCE

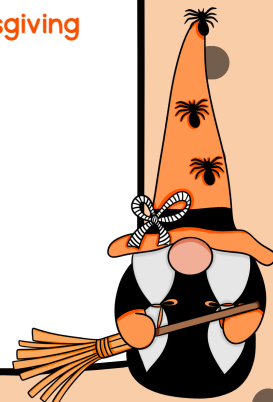
